Attendance - Arrive on time all the time

As we are now well into the Autumn Term, we want to remind all pupils and parents/guardians about the need for regular attendance to school. Despite it being the second full week back at school we have had a small minority of pupils staying off school unnecessarily and with reasons that we are not able to authorise. We must remind all parents/guardians that the The Department for Education (DfE) have confirmed that the following responsibilities have now resumed:

- Parents' duty to ensure that their child attends regularly at school where the child is a registered pupil.
- Schools' responsibilities to record attendance and follow up absence.
- The availability to issue sanctions, including fixed penalty notices in line with local authorities' codes of conduct.

Our aim is to continue to support all pupils to come to school regularly by providing practical help and sensitivity where there are difficulties with pupils attending whatever the reason. Please can we remind parents/guardians of the need for open communication, and if your child is unable to come to school it is vital that you telephone school and discuss the reason with us.

Each morning our pastoral team will look at pupil absence and depending on the reason for the absence, and the pupils previous school attendance if your child is absent then it is very likely you will receive a home visit from one of our pastoral team. In last week's article we reminded parents/guardians of the key members of our pastoral team and in addition please see below for the members of our team working on pupil attendance.

Please see below some hints and tips

regarding school attendance:

Practical strategies for helping your child attend school regularly

on Tins

Make school attendance non-negotiable unless there is a genuine illness – create a good habit from the start.

- Make sure uniform is ready, especially after the holidays or weekend.
- Set the alarm clock early enough to allow plenty of time to get ready.
- Talk to your child about school life and if they are unhappy about any aspect, tell us as soon as possible so we can try to resolve the issue.
- Ensure medical/dental appointments are made out of school hours. If this is not possible, your child should not miss a whole day of school and they should attend either before and/or after the appointment.
- Talk to your child about how important it is to attend school every day.
- If you think your child is trying to avoid school, or certain days, please try to find out why and let us know.
- If your family are experiencing any difficulties, talk to your school who may be able to offer help.
