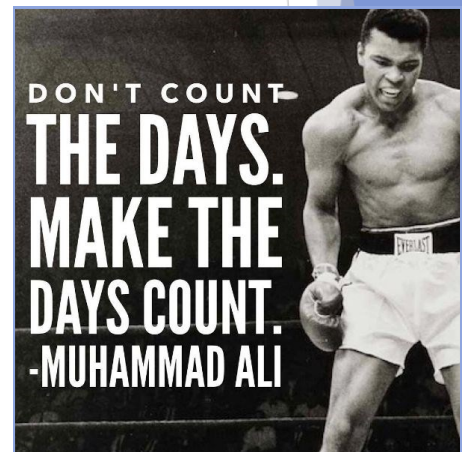
Hillside High School **Kit Expectations**
