The week beginning 16th June pupils are only required to attend their exams and allotted workshops.

Monday 16th June

- P1: Physics Exam – All pupils must attend
- P2: Music and Spanish Workshop (Other pupils may leave school following the Physics exam)
- P3: Music and Spanish Workshop (pupils not sitting Music may leave school following Period 3)
- P4: Music Exam

Tuesday 17th June

- P1: Spanish Exam (only Spanish pupils to attend)
- P2: Spanish Exam (only Spanish pupils to attend)
- P3: DT workshop – all pupils studying DT with Mr Lambert to attend
- P4: DT workshop – all pupils studying DT with Mr Lambert to attend

Wednesday 18th June

- P1: DT exam

If pupils don't have an exam on that day, they need to arrive to school for **10.45am** for registration **in full school uniform** for the **Annual Year 11 Leavers Breakfast**. They will be dismissed at **12.30pm**.
