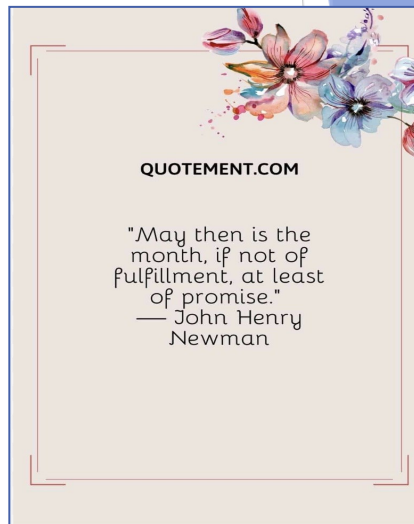
Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Coronation of King Charles III

- King Charles III's coronation will take place on Saturday 6th May 2023 at Westminster Abbey in London.
- During the ceremony, the King will be crowned alongside Camilla, the Queen Consort.
- A coronation is both the symbolic religious ceremony during which a sovereign is crowned and the physical act of placing a crown on a monarch's head.
- It formalises the monarch's role as the head of the Church of England and marks the transfer of their title and powers.

7 TIPS FOR MANAGING EXAM STRESS



FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

FOR PARENTS/CARERS

Stay organised with to-do lists and study timetables



Give them time off chores and non-urgent family stuff

Take regular study breaks



Encourage them to keep doing the activities they did before exams

Have a dedicated study space



Help them set up a study space and make sure the rest of the family understands

Have a long term goal



Chat with them about what they want to do after exams

Get as much sleep as possible



Remind them to go to bed at a regular time each night
