



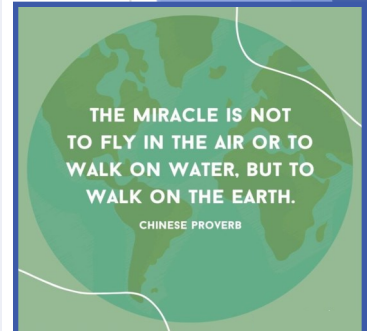
Dear Parents/Guardians,

#kNOwKnifeCrime

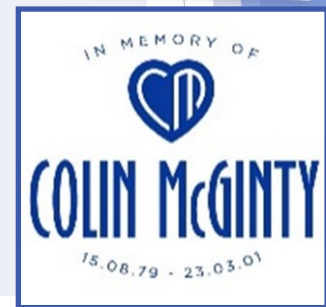
We want to keep our community safe and be well resourced in the event someone needs medical assistance!

This week during assembly #kNOwKnifeCrime campaigner Laura Hughes launched Sefton's Bleed Control Kit Cabinet Campaign which involves 84 schools all over Sefton. At Hillside we understand the importance of raising the profile of the dangers of knife crime and its consequences. As such we felt as a school that it was of the utmost importance that we take an active role in this campaign.

On Wednesday 17th April a relay event will take place whereby a bleed control kit baton will be passed between schools within the Strand Learning Partnership. The bleed control kit baton will arrive at Hillside from Bedford Primary School where the baton will be passed to us and it's then our job to keep the relay going by continuing the run to Christ Church Primary!

Following this and to show our solidarity for such an important and worthy cause we would like Hillside pupils to complete their very own mini marathon on Friday 17th April. On this day Hillside staff and pupils will run 2.6 miles on a carefully selected route around Hillside's grounds to raise money for the #KnowKnifeCrime campaign.

We are hoping to raise as much money as possible for this worthy cause and we would be grateful of any donations, no matter how big or how small, every little bit counts. We will be sending out an email to families with a link in the very near future for those who wish to sponsor us.

KIDS EAT FREE EASTER HOLIDAYS 2024 (OR FOR £1)

MORRISONS

Kids eat for free in Morrisons Cafes every day from 3pm when you spend over £4.50 on a adult's meal.

YO! SUSHI

Kids under 10 get a free bento box deal, plus a drink when an adult spends at least £10. Offer runs 25 March - 12 April 2024.

DOBBIES GARDEN CENTRE

Every day from noon, kids can eat from the Dobbies lunch or pick 'n' mix menu for free when an adult gets a main meal.

GORDON RAMSEY RESTAURANT

Kids under 8 can eat for free at Gordon Ramsey Restaurants when an adults eats from the à la carte menu.

BILL'S

Up to two children can eat for free at Bill's from 25 March - 12 April (exc Sat/Sun) when an adult orders a main dish.

ASDA

Kids eat for £1 with no minimum spend. Plus, they get a free piece of fruit such as and apple, pear or banana.

PAUSA CAFÉ at DUNELM

Spend £4 and get one free choice from the Kids Menu in Pausa Cafés on Monday to Friday after 3pm.

THE REAL GREEK

Children under 12 years can have a free meal (29 Mar-14 Apr), plus a drink and ice cream, when an adult spends over £10.

BEEFEATER

Get two free kids' breakfasts for those under 16s at Beefeater when you buy an unlimited adult breakfast.

TESCO

Kids eat for free, with a 60p minimum spend Monday to Friday in Tesco Cafes. Clubcard needed.

PRETO

Kids aged under 10 eat free from mid-day at Preto. Download a voucher from their site before you go.

TGI Fridays

Kids eat a free all day, every day, when an adult buys a main meal and presents their Stripes loyalty card.
